Following lunch the group got down to the business of planning club events for 2020. Our three Highway Pickup dates were established in March, and June, as they have been in years past, and October this year. Texas Healey RoundUp is again in April with CONCLAVE 2020 being in May. Prior to CONCLAVE an additional event in May will be a drive through the Hill Country with lunch at the Alamo Springs Café which has been featured in the past on the front cover of *Texas Monthly* magazine. This year the club will undertake a project of getting electric fuel pump cutout switches installed in as many club members' cars as possible. This device is a **very important safety addition** to our 50+ year old cars. Only 948 Sprites have a mechanical fuel pump. But **all other Healeys need a cutout switch**. All new cars *must* have some means of shutting off the electric fuel pumps in the event of a collision. This is to prevent gasoline/diesel fuel continuing to being pumped in case a fuel line is broken on impact before the ignition can be shut off. The need to eliminate the risk of fire is obvious.

So to accomplish our goal we will have two tech sessions in July to install these important devices. One will be at the Adkins' home, and the other a week later at the Richmonds'. These locations were chosen to be convenient for members living in the Austin area or San Antonio area. **But** you may come to **either** session, whichever suits

you and your schedule best.

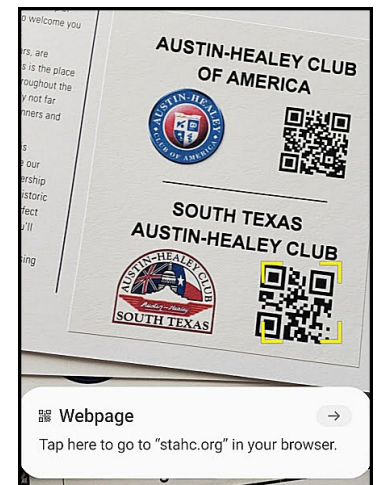
These switches cost \$52.50. There is no labor or other costs. This amount is probably the **best insurance bargain** out there. And, unlike conventional insurance coverage, this is a one-time cost, not a recurring annual premium. So for your safety and piece of mind please plan on having your car so equipped.

## 31st ANNUAL SAN ANTONIO JAGUAR CLUB RALLYE TO LUCKENBACH

Saturday morning, January 25, started off cloudy and chilly with a slight threat of precipitation that didn't occur. The Rallye began in Helotes at the El Chaparral Mexican Restaurant. Jaguar Club and STAHC member Brian Blackwell was the rally master. Registration was inside the restaurant. After consuming a breakfast taco or two the cars departed at 1 minute intervals from the parking lot. Club members participating were Jim Richmond with Karen navigating, and Ron Borden drove his Sprite with long-time friend, Glen Bilyeu, as his navigator. Mike McPhail from the Gulf Coast Healey Club also ran the rally in his TR-6.

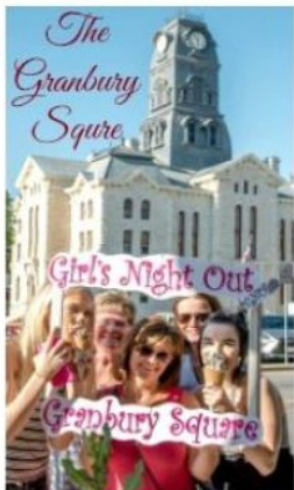
